

## FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIPS: APPLY TO THE UNIVERSITY BY NOVEMBER 15 FOR AUTOMATIC CONSIDERATION

SCHOLARSHIP	AWARDS/BENEFITS	ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS
National Merit Scholars	\$5,000/year, up to four years*	Designation as a National Merit Finalist by the National Merit Scholarship Corp.; submit certificate copy
National Achievement Scholars	\$5,000/year, up to four years*	Designation as a National Achievement Finalist by the National Merit Scholarship Corp.; submit certificate copy
National Hispanic Scholars	\$5,000/year, up to four years*	Designation as a National Hispanic Scholar by the College Board in the National Hispanic Recognition Program; submit certificate copy

Florida Resident: Must be classified as in-state for tuition purposes.

President's Gold	\$5,000/year, up to four years	<b>3.9 weighted GPA and 1850 SAT</b> (Critical Reading, Math & Writing) <b>or 28 ACT</b> ; Higher test scores may be considered if submitted after admission; subject to scholarship availability
President's Silver	\$3,000/year, up to four years	<b>3.5 - 3.89 weighted GPA and 1700 SAT</b> (Critical Reading, Math & Writing) <b>or 25 ACT</b> ; Higher test scores may be considered if submitted after admission; subject to scholarship availability

Non-Florida Resident: Must be classified as out-of-state for tuition purposes.

Blue & Green Scholars Award	\$15,000/year, up to four years	<b>3.9 weighted GPA and 1850 SAT</b> (Critical Reading, Math & Writing) <b>or 28 ACT</b> ; Higher test scores may be considered if submitted after admission; subject to scholarship availability
Blue & Green Directors Award	\$10,000/year, up to four years	<b>3.5 - 3.89 weighted GPA and 1700 SAT</b> (Critical Reading, Math & Writing) <b>or 25 ACT</b> ; Higher test scores may be considered if submitted after admission; subject to scholarship availability

Florida Resident: Must be classified as in-state for tuition purposes		
Phi Theta Kappa All-Florida Academic Team	Full tuition	Team A and Team B recipients with letters of award
Phi Theta Kappa	\$750/semester, up to four semesters	3.5 GPA or higher; Must be a member of Phi Theta Kappa with an AA degree from a Florida college
Eagle Transfer	\$500/semester, up to four semesters	3.0 GPA or higher; Competitive award based on selection criteria and financial need
Non-Florida Resident: Must be classified as out-of-state for tuition purposes		
Out-of-State Waiver	6 credit hours; Fall and Spring semesters only	Award is competitive and based on committee review of the student's waiver application
ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS		
Latin American Caribbean Scholarship	\$250/semester; student pays in-state tuition rate	3.4 GPA or 1560 SAT (Critical Reading, Math & Writing) or 23 ACT; International students with an F-1 Visa; citizen/resident of a Latin American or Caribbean country
In-State Tuition Waiver	12 credit hours of tuition/semester Fall and Spring semesters only	Must be a Florida resident; priority is given to students who belong to one of these recognized outreach programs: AVID, CROP, HOPE Advanced, Immokalee Foundation, PSEP/Scholars Program, Take Stock in Children
Dual-Enrolled Students at FGCU		
Accelerated Collegiate Experience (ACE) Honors Graduates	\$5,000/year, up to three years	3.9 weighted GPA and 1850 SAT (Critical Reading, Math & Writing) or 28 ACT; Complete ACE program including HS graduation and continue at FGCU
ACE non-Honors graduates	\$2,000/year, up to three years	3.0 FGCU GPA and completion of 12 or more credit hours at FGCU; Complete ACE program including HS graduation and continue at FGCU
State College of Florida Collegiate School	Tuition and fees for up to 72 credit hours or max. 3 years	State College of Florida Collegiate School graduate with an AA and 3.0 GPA
