President's Gold

- \$5,000 per year up to four years
- Must apply to the University for admission by November 15th
- 3.9 GPA and SAT 1850 or ACT 28

National Merit Finalist, National Achievement Finalist, National Hispanic Scholar

- \$5,000 per year up to four years
- Provide proof of award and recognition

Admission's Merit

- \$2,000 one-time award
- Must apply to the University for admission by November 15th
- Ranked according to a combination of GPA and test scores

Phi Theta Kappa

- \$750 per semester for four semesters; Merit scholarship
- Must submit scholarship application by published deadlines
- Incoming transfer from a Florida college with an AA degree, member of PTK, 3.5 GPA or higher

Eagle Transfer

- \$500 per semester for four semesters; Competitive award based on selection criteria and financial need
- Must submit scholarship application by published deadlines
- Incoming transfer from a Florida college with an AA degree

Latin American Caribbean Scholarship

LAC scholarship

- \$250 per semester (student pays the in-state tuition rate)
- Must be an International Students with an F-1 VISA
- Must be a citizen/resident of a Latin American or Caribbean country
- Minimum GPA 3.4 or SAT 1560 or ACT 23

Tuition Waivers – For Freshman and Transfers

In-State Waiver

- Up to 12 credits of tuition waiver (does not cover per credit hour fees)
- Must submit scholarship application by published deadlines
- Competitive award based on selection criteria
- Priority given to students involved in recognized outreach programs (AVID, CROP, TSIC, etc.)

Out-of-State Waiver

- Up to six credit hours of tuition waiver (covers the difference in tuition between the out-of-state rate and in-state rate)
- Must submit scholarship application by published deadlines
- Competitive award based on selection criteria and a minimum GPA of 3.4

Accelerated Collegiate Experience (ACE) Honors Graduates

- \$5,000 per year for up to three years
- Complete the ACE program which includes HS graduation
- Submit application through the ACE program office by the published date
- 3.9 GPA and SAT 1850 or ACT 28

ACE non-Honors Graduates

- \$2,000 per year for up to three years
- For ACE students who are part-time or full-time continuing at FGCU after HS graduation
- Submit application through the ACE program office by the published date
- Minimum FGCU GPA of 3.0 and completion of at least 12 credit hours at FGCU
