CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Student must start the process six months to a year in advance
- Student must have a declared major or minor in the Lutgert College of Business or the written approval of the Dean or Academic Advisor of their College.
- Student must have earned a minimum of 60 credits and a 3.0 GPA prior to participating in the exchange program.
- Student must have always met the FGCU's Code of Conduct.

STUDENT MUST:

- Obtain a Letter of Recommendation from a full-time FGCU faculty in their major. (Sample attached.)
- Submit a written Personal Statement. (Sample attached.)
- Submit a copy of valid passport (must not expire at least six months prior to anticipated return date).

- Identify possible funding sources
- Non-business students need to work with their Academic Advisor to identify courses they can take at the partner university.
