## All Applicants

- **Submit the Graduate Application online or paper format**  
\*Previous and current FGCU students only submit paper application
- **\$30 Application Fee**  
\*Previous and current FGCU students do not have to pay the \$30 fee
- **Submit two official transcripts from each college/university attended**  
\*Transcripts must be in the original sealed envelope from the institution to be considered official
- **Sit for the GRE, MAT, or GMAT** (according to program requirements) **and request scores be sent to FGCU**
- **Complete all supplemental requirements of the program** (see next page)

## Admission Requirements

### Master of Arts (M.A.) English

Applicants must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 or a combined score of at least 1000 on the GRE, the names and contact information of 2 college or university faculty members who will serve as references, a statement of personal goals, and a writing sample of 8-10 pages.

### Master of Science (M.S.) Environmental Science

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA in upper-division coursework (last 60 credit hours of baccalaureate degree), a combined score of 1000 on the GRE with a minimum of 400 on the verbal and quantitative sections.

Submit two letters of recommendation, a cover letter of introduction and a statement of research goals. Prerequisite: General ecology course and statistics course.

### Master of Arts (M.A.) Environmental Studies

Applicants must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA in upper-division coursework (last 60 credit hours of baccalaureate degree), a combined score of 1000 on the GRE with a minimum of 400 on the verbal and quantitative sections. Submit three letters of recommendation from people familiar with the applicant's academic and research potential, a cover letter of introduction including a statement of research goals and career interests. ### Master of Arts (M.A.) History

Applicants must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 (with at least 15 credits in History and a 3.0 GPA in all History courses), a combined score of at least 1000 on the GRE with a minimum of 500 on the verbal section, two letters of recommendation from past professors or mentors, and a personal statement of interest in pursuing graduate work in history (2-3 pages).

### Master of Science (M.S.) Mathematics

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 for the most recent 60 credit hours of upper division undergraduate or graduate coursework, a minimum combined score of 1000 on the GRE, a cover letter of introduction (expression of interest), and three letters of recommendation from academic sources capable of assessing your ability to succeed in a graduate program.
