### Paper

Complete the application, residency classification, and immunization history form\*

### All Applicants

- Submit two official transcripts from each college/university attended.\* Transcripts must be in the original sealed envelope from the institution to be considered official
- Sit for the GRE, MAT, or GMAT (according to program requirements) and request scores be sent to FGCU
- Complete all supplemental requirements of the program
- Submit application materials and a \$30 application fee\* to:

\*Previous and current students of FGCU are not required to submit a new immunization record, transcripts (unless not already on file), or the application fee. Transcripts from institutions attended after enrollment at FGCU are still required.

### International Applicants

- International students (and U.S. students with international transcripts) must have a course by course evaluation of international transcripts by an approved private company, such as, World Education Services, Josef Silny and Associates, INC or AACRAO
- Applicants from countries where English is not the official language must submit a minimum TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 550 (paper-based test) or 213 (computer-based test) or 79 (Internet-based)

## Admission Requirements

### **Master of Arts (M.A.) Counseling: Mental Health Counseling**

University minimum requirements apply. Applicants must submit GRE or MAT scores, personal statement and three recommendation forms. <http://coe.fgcu.edu/mentalhealth/recommendationform.pdf>

### **Master of Education (M.Ed.) Curriculum and Instruction**

*Concentrations in English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Generalist*

### **Master of Education (M.Ed.) Elementary Education**

### **Master of Education (M.Ed.) Reading**

### **Master of Education (M.Ed.) Special Education**

Applicants must submit GRE or MAT scores, proof of certification or eligibility for professional certification, and three letters of recommendation.

### **Master of Arts (M.A.)/Master of Education (M.Ed.) C&I: Educational Technology**

Applicants must submit GRE or MAT scores, three letters of recommendation, and proof of certification (M.Ed. only)

### **Master of Arts (M.A.)/Master of Education (M.Ed.) Educational Leadership**

Applicants must submit GRE or MAT scores and three letters of recommendation, proof of certification or eligibility for professional certification is required for the M.Ed.

### **Master of Arts (M.A.)/Master of Education (M.Ed.) Counseling: School Counseling**

Applicants must submit GRE or MAT scores, personal statement, proof of professional certification or passing score on FTCE General Knowledge Test (or 1000 on GRE), and three recommendation forms.

### **Educational Specialist (Ed.S.) in Education**

*Concentrations in Curriculum & Instruction and Educational Leadership*

Applicants must have a master's degree in an education or related field from a regionally accredited institution with a GPA of at least 3.5. Applicants must also have a combined score of 1000 on the GRE or a minimum score of 400 on the MAT, and submit GRE analytical writing scores, resume, and three letters of recommendation.
