All Applicants

- Submit two official transcripts from each college/university attended.* Transcripts must be in the original sealed envelope from the institution to be considered official
- Sit for the GRE, MAT, or GMAT (according to program requirements) and request scores be sent to FGCU
- Complete all supplemental requirements of the program
- Submit application materials and a \$30 application fee* to:

*Previous and current students of FGCU are not required to submit a new immunization record, transcripts (unless not already on file), or the application fee. Transcripts from institutions attended after enrollment at FGCU are still required.

International Applicants

- International students (and U.S. students with international transcripts) must have a course by course evaluation of international transcripts by an approved private company, such as, World Education Services, Josef Silny and Associates, INC or AACRAO
- Applicants from countries where English is not the official language must submit a minimum TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 550 (paper-based test) or 213 (computer-based test) or 79 (Internet-based)

Admission Requirements

Master of Science (M.S.) Health Science

Concentrations in Health Professions Education, Health Services Administration

Applicants must meet one of the following requirements:

- (Combined score of GRE quantitative and verbal sections) + (GPA for the last 60 semester hours attempted at the upper division undergraduate level x 200) must equal or exceed 1600; or
- (MAT score) + (GPA for the last 60 semester hours attempted at the upper division undergraduate level x 200) must equal or exceed 1000; or
- (GMAT score) + (GPA for the last 60 semester hours attempted at the upper division undergraduate level x 200) must equal or exceed 1100; or
- A graduate degree from a regionally accredited institution

Master of Science (M.S.) Occupational Therapy

Applicants must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0, a combined score of 1000 on the GRE, and 10 hours of volunteer, work, or shadowing experience in an OT practice environment. Applicant must also submit a supplemental application and personal statement.

Doctor of Physical Therapy (D.P.T.)

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA in all upper division coursework (last 60 credit hours of the baccalaureate degree), GRE scores with a minimum combined score of 1000 on the quantitative and verbal sections and a minimum score of 4.0 on the analytical section, and submit a portfolio, including validation of two physical therapist shadowing experiences of five hours each.
