USER'S GUIDE

Recycling Right

Plastic bags, foods, liquids, and horticulture contaminate recycling containers. When a container is contaminated **all contents** are thrown away by the waste management company!

Please be sure to:

- Reuse plastic bags or throw them away.
- Empty out all containers prior to taking them to the recycling center.



PAPER

Recyclable:

- Newspaper
- Computer & office paper
- Magazines
- Catalogues
- Corrugated cardboard (including clean empty pizza boxes)
- Fiberboard (including cereal and cracker boxes, beverage carrying containers, shoe and gift boxes, etc.)
- Paper grocery bags
- Telephone books
- Junk mail

Not Recyclable

- Cardboard packaging with wax layer (juice boxes, milk cartons, etc.)

ALUMINUM

Recyclable:

- Clean cans
- Foil
- Pie pans

Not Recyclable

- Lawn furniture
- Cooking utensils
- Door screens
- Pots/Pans

METAL

Recyclable:

- Clean cans
- Empty aerosol cans

Not Recyclable

- Knives
- Forks
- Spoons
- License plates
- Car parts
- Tools

PLASTICS

Recyclable:

- Empty rigid containers with #1-7 in the recycling symbol on the bottom

Not Recyclable

- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Eggs cartons
- Auto fluid containers
- Pool chemical bottles
- Newspaper sleeves
- Polystyrene trays
- Flower pots

GLASS

Recyclable:

- Clear, green, and brown glass and jars

Not Recyclable

- Drinking glasses
- Dishes
- Mirrors
- Windows
- Medicine bottles
- Cookware (including Pyrex, Corning, etc.)
