

Qualifications & Compensation

Qualifications

In order to be eligible to apply for and maintain a Resident Assistant position, you must meet the following qualifications:

- Must have been an FGCU student for at least 1 semester
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Must be in good disciplinary standing with the University
- Must be a student enrolled in at least one credit hour per semester at FGCU

Compensation

Below is the Resident Assistant compensation breakdown for each specific community. In addition to the items listed below you will also receive staff shirts, food during RA training, and opportunities to work at the reception desk for extra pay.

North Lake Village:

- Free housing accommodations for each semester you are employed. Once hired, you will have the opportunity to choose your roommates. Potential roommates will need to complete housing agreements and a separate RA roommate agreement.
- A stipend of \$750 per semester. The stipend is paid over the course of the semester through bi-weekly paychecks (you get a paycheck every other week).

South Village:

- Free housing accommodations for each semester you are employed. All South Village RA rooms are single occupancy (no roommate).
- A 100-block meal plan per semester. Meal plan also includes 300 dining dollars. Meal plans are accepted at SoVi Dining (Fresh Food Company) and the Perch. Dining dollars can be redeemed at Starbucks, Subway, Taco Bell and Einstein's.

West Lake Village:

- Free housing accommodations for each semester you are employed. Once hired, you will have the opportunity to choose your roommates. Potential roommates will need to complete housing agreements and a separate RA roommate agreement.
- A stipend of \$750 per semester. The stipend is paid over the course of the semester through bi-weekly paychecks.
