

PARKING SERVICES NEWS!!

Count on the Parking Services Division at Florida Gulf Coast University for your parking needs and information:

Important things you need to know:

- All Vehicles must be registered with a valid permit to park on university property. Students must register on Gulfline for a parking permit. Any changes to vehicle information must be reported to Parking Services immediately.
- Park only in lots assigned to permit/decal type. Housing residents must obtain housing decals.
- The primary parking areas for commuter students are: **Garages #1, #2, #3, #4, Lot #6, Lot#7, and the Auxiliary Lot (lime stone lot) next to Garage #1.**
- Vehicles must be parked in valid parking spaces. Do not park in the grass or along curbs. Motorcycles must be parked in designated motorcycle space or the non-elevator corners of the garages.
- Student vehicles are prohibited from the rear of Howard Hall and the rear of the library. Those are restricted access roads. **Dropping off of students in these areas is prohibited.**
- **DO NOT** block, park or obstruct any handicapped space. **Reserved, restricted and handicapped spaces are enforced at all times.**
- Visitor Parking: Visitors must obtain a visitor pass to park on campus. **Students are never considered visitors.**
- Commuter Students: Hanging permit must be displayed from the rearview mirror or on the left side of the dash, with permit number facing outward. Permit is only valid for use in the vehicle it is registered to. Commuter students may register two vehicles under the same permit.
- Housing Students: Residents may only register one vehicle. Parking decal must be permanently affixed to left side of windshield. **DO NOT DRIVE** to main campus until after 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- From 6:00 p.m. to 7 a.m. and on weekends all main campus lots are general parking, **EXCLUDING RESERVED/RESTRICTED SPACES which are enforced 24/7.**
- Housing lots and garage are restricted Monday through Friday from 1:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Vehicles must have a housing decal displayed during these non-visiting hours to park in housing lots and garage.
- Parking garages # 1, 2, 3, and 4 close from 12 midnight to 5:00 a.m. Vehicles parked in these garages during this time will be cited. The use of skateboards, roller-skates, in line skates, or similar devices, are prohibited within parking garages.
- Shuttles-Housing Shuttles run any day classes are in session during the Fall and Spring semesters, from 7:00am-10:00pm. On days shuttles do not operate housing residents may park on campus in commuter student lots/garages only.
- Parking Citations: Must be paid within 10 calendar days of issue or a \$10 late fee is automatically assessed. Payment can be made by credit card, check, or cash at the cashier's office. Payment may also be made with credit card or check via Gulfline Bill and Payment Center if it is the only outstanding debt on account.
- Appealing Citations: go to <http://gulfline.fgcu.edu> . Just a reminder - "all decisions made by the Appeals Board are final." Lack of knowledge of parking regulations, lateness for class, or inability to locate an authorized parking space are not valid grounds for appeal.
- The operation and parking of a motor vehicle on University property is a privilege - not a right.
- Acceptance of a decal/permit shall be deemed acknowledgement of the requirements, and an agreement to adhere to the regulations. For more information go to: <http://www.fgcu.edu/Parking>

SHUTTLE APP

DoubleMap is a real-time GPS shuttle bus tracking system. It allows riders to track the exact location of the campus shuttle buses in real time.

Features include:

- View buses in real time on the map
- View specific routes and associated stops
- View your current location if GPS is enabled
- View current bus system related announcements such as delays and re-routing

To see the routes and exact location of a shuttle in real-time download the **DoubleMap** App.

Rave Guardian Eagle App

The FGCU Police Department offers the Guardian Eagle system free for all students. Guardian Eagle system provides increased security by transforming your cell phone into a personal safety device.

Features include:

- The ability to contact the University Police or 911 with the click of one button
- The ability to send the University Police anonymous tips & photo content via text messaging
- The ability to use a safety timer and select Guardians to make sure you reach your destination

Users can use a profile to provide important emergency information and your location will be provided, to assist with emergency responses, when the emergency buttons are activated. (Users must use an FGCU email account to sign in and register). Download the **Rave Guardian** App from your smart phone.
