

College of Business College Marshall Selection Criteria

In 1999, FGCU began a new tradition of including College Marshall's in the Graduation Ceremony. College Marshall's carry the College of Business Banner and wear a special sash with the University Logo embroidered on one end, and their name embroidered on the other.

Responsibilities

- Head the College Processional at Fall and Spring Semester Graduation Ceremonies (and perform other ceremonial tasks as may be required throughout the year)
- Sit with graduating Business students at the Graduation Ceremony
- Escort the students to the platform to receive their diplomas
- Serve on the University Graduation Committee the year following service as College Marshall

Eligibility

Full-time, continuing faculty on multi-year, tenure or tenure earning appointments.

Process and Criteria

The following criteria will be considered, individually or in combination, in selection of the College of Business Marshall in the Fall Semester of each Academic Year. Selection of the Marshall will be made through the Office of the Dean from nominations by the Department Chairs. Department Chairs may nominate up to one faculty member from each discipline in their department. The intent of the process is to confer stature on the College Marshall, and ensure honor to the role.

1. Outstanding service and commitment to the College and students. Faculty must have demonstrated service that contributed to the growth of the college, and promoted and advanced the interests of students during the previous academic year.
2. College nominee for Professor of the Year. Such persons are usually nominated and competitively selected based upon a combination of superior and innovative teaching, outstanding scholarship and service during the previous academic year.
3. XX Award Winner – Faculty/Staff members nominated and competitively selected based upon service contributions to University during the previous academic year.
