JUDICIAL AFFAIRS

1. A resource library has been collected for providing sanctioned students with on and off campus community service and counseling options.

Students have been sanctioned to complete more community service on campus. Other departments, such as Housing, Campus Recreation, and Prevention and Wellness have partnered with Judicial Affairs to provide approved community service opportunities for sanctioned students on campus.

The Student Code of Conduct has been revised to incorporate the changes in student behavior and technology since its origin in 2003.

2. Panhellenic has begun the extension process to bring a new NPC sorority on campus for fall 2007. IFC efforts are in progress. The Greek Life Expansion Committee was developed and has approved one fraternity to return to campus and a multicultural fraternity to be established on our campus for spring 2007. Steps have been taken to create a unified Greek Counsel with representatives from each organization. Greek Week 2007 occurred in the spring.

3. Student Life provides international student support services, study abroad programs, judicial programming, multicultural services and programs, student support services for a diverse student body. Advising, programming, promotion and new developments will be evaluated.

4. Student clubs and organizations will continue to be developed along with leadership development and training programs. Intramural and recreation programs will be enhanced. Greek life development will continue.

This program is required by the university Alcohol Policy for any Student Organizations that will be hosting an event with alcohol. Other assessments were provided by students through word of mouth and their comments were noted to the Dean of Students.
