Students must complete at least 6 hours of Intercultural Knowledge coursework, marked below as "INKN." Students will gain measurable skills in Written Communication, Quantitative Reasoning, and Critical Thinking by completing FGCU's General Education Program.

To prevent or minimize excess hours, students should select General Education courses that satisfy common prerequisite requirements for their intended major.

Students must enroll in one Natural Sciences course with a lab or field experience as designated by C or L following the 4-digit course number.

General Education Program Minimum Grade Policy

Students must earn a minimum grade of C in all General Education courses used to satisfy the Communication, Mathematics, State Core Humanities, State Core Social Sciences, and State Core Natural Sciences areas. A grade of C- (C minus) does not satisfy the requirement of a minimum grade of C.
