FGCU students pursuing an academic program of study in Scotland during the Spring, Summer, or Fall 2020 semesters are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

- Recipients will be U.S. citizens or permanent residents, undergraduate students. Preference will be given to students who are residents of Collier or Lee County, Florida;
- Recipients must currently have and maintain a minimum 2.8 GPA;
- Recipients must demonstrate community service as required by FGCU. Student involvement in leadership, campus or community activities is beneficial;
- Recipients must already either be admitted to or applying for, through FGCU International Services, a study abroad program in a school in Scotland before applying for this scholarship.

Application deadline:

Oct. 30th for Spring 2020 programs / February 15th for Summer and Fall programs

Award Amount:

up to \$6000.00 USD for semester programs and \$4000 for summer programs

Scholarship to Study Abroad in Scotland

Instructions and Criteria of Eligibility

1. Applicants must have a University Identification Number (UIN) issued by FGCU. Acceptance to FGCU is required prior to consideration of your application; therefore, applicants must be currently enrolled FGCU students
2. Applicants must have at least one full semester of FGCU coursework to complete toward degree study following completion of the study abroad experience in Scotland.
3. Complete the application in full (including essay and program costs as noted below). Address your interest in, and future plans after completing, study in Scotland; You may include Scottish heritage, customs, history, culture or awareness of the contributions of the people of Scotland to the development of the U.S. and world; and why you believe this scholarship would be helpful to you.
4. Since St. Andrew's Society Scholarship for Study Abroad may be merit or need based, you must complete the FAFSA* ([Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#)). By completing the FAFSA, before the annual priority deadline of October 1st, you may also be eligible for additional Federal and Institutional Aid. **It takes several months for the U.S. Government and the FGCU Office of Financial Aid to process a FAFSA after it's submitted. To confirm you have a current FAFSA, call the FGCU Office of Financial Aid at (239) 590-7920.*
5. To be eligible for the Federal Pell Grant or federal loans, a student must also complete a Financial Aid Consortium Agreement. The agreement can be found on the Financial Aid website under Study Abroad. You do not need to receive federal grants or loans to receive the Saint Andrews Society Scholarship.
6. Scholarship recipients will be U.S. citizens or permanent residents, undergraduate students. Preference will be given to students who are residents of Collier or Lee County Florida.
7. Scholarship recipients must currently have and maintain a minimum 2.8 GPA.
8. Scholarship recipients must demonstrate community service as required by FGCU. Student involvement in leadership, campus or community activities is desirable.
9. Scholarship recipients must already either be admitted to or applying for, through FGCU International Services, a study abroad program in a school in Scotland before applying for this scholarship. Study period must be for a minimum of four weeks.
10. Scholarship recipients must return to FGCU for at least one full semester to complete degree study following the study abroad experience.
11. The top scholarship applicants and or recipients may be interviewed by members of the St. Andrew's Society.
12. Scholarship recipients must agree to make a presentation on his/her experience to the St. Andrew's Society following the completion of the study abroad program in Scotland (expenses for students to participate in these interviews/ presentations will be covered by the St. Andrews Society).
13. St. Andrews Society and FGCU International Services reserve the right to determine award recipients and amounts.

Submissions due by October 30, 2019 for Spring programs or February 15, 2020 for Summer or Fall programs

This award will be reported to FGCU Financial Aid Office and may impact the student's overall financial aid profile. *If you withdraw from a program for any reason (voluntary or involuntary), any award you may have received may be revoked. If your award is revoked after funds have been disbursed to you, you will be responsible for returning any outstanding or prorated award amount.*

Provide these costs in U.S. dollars.
