Program Description

The Master of Education (MEd) and the Master of Arts (MA) in Educational Leadership explore the functions of educational leaders and stress the relationship between tested practice and applied theory.

The MEd in Educational Leadership program prepares students for leadership positions in educational settings and improves the performance of current leaders. Graduates are prepared for Educational Leadership certification by the Florida Department of Education. The MA in Educational Leadership is for students not seeking certification. Admissions Requirements

- FGCU graduate application
- Official academic transcripts from every college or university attended
- Baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution
- GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale in the last 60 hours of undergraduate coursework
- Three letters of recommendation from professionals in the field on letterhead.
 - Candidates for the M.Ed. program must include a letter of recommendation from their school principal.
- International students must have a satisfactory score on the TOEFL exam (minimum score of 550 paper-based, 213 computer-based, or 79 internet-based) for students from countries where English is not the primary language
- GRE or MAT is not required for consideration. However, if the GPA falls below the required 3.0, other substantiating evidence of scholarship, including reporting test scores, may be requested

Application Deadlines

Fall – July 1
Spring – October 15
Summer – March 1

Additional M.Ed. Specific Requirements

- Professional teaching certificate or eligibility for a Florida professional teaching certificate
- At least two years of successful K-12 teaching experience

Satisfaction of minimum University and program requirements does not guarantee admission to a graduate program. Applicants should check with the program for the most up to date admission requirements prior to commencing the application process.
