Program Description

The Transitional Doctor of Physical Therapy (tDPT) program is designed to meet the needs of the practicing Physical Therapist with either a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Physical Therapy. The distance learning format allows students to continue with their practice while augmenting their knowledge and skills to reflect contemporary physical therapy practice at the clinical doctor level. Admissions Requirements

- FGCU graduate application
- Official academic transcripts from every college or university attended
- Baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution
- Baccalaureate or Master's degree in Physical Therapy from a program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE)
- Active Physical Therapy license in good standing issued by the State of Florida
- Graduate Record Exam (GRE) official scores
 - Verbal & Quantitative = 35th percentile
 - Analytical Writing minimum = 4.0
- GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for upper level undergraduate coursework
- International students must have a satisfactory score on the TOEFL exam (minimum score of 550 paper-based, 213 computer-based, or 79 internet-based) for students from countries where English is not the primary language

Satisfaction of minimum University and program requirements does not guarantee admission to a graduate program. Applicants should check with the program for the most up to date admission requirements prior to commencing the application process.

Applications are considered for rolling admissions for all terms.

Applicants entering with a BSPT are required to complete all 30 credit hours of coursework, while those entering with a MSPT will receive a plan of study based on transcript evaluation (typically 18-20 credit hours). Per university policy, a maximum of 12 credit hours of non-FGCU coursework may be transferred in.
