



## **Graduate Fellowship for Out-of-State Graduate Student Tuition Support**

**DEADLINES:** Fall semester—May 1<sup>st</sup> (by 5:00pm); Spring semester—October 1<sup>st</sup> (by 5:00pm)

- Graduate tuition support provides assistance for out-state tuition. It does not cover undergraduate courses or any fees other than tuition.
- Graduate students apply for the Graduate Fellowship must be admitted as degree-seeking students for the semester of which the awards are sought. Post-bac non-degree seeking students and certificate students are *not* eligible to apply.
- This award is authorized for non-resident students only. Undocumented students, including students, who have received deferred action (DACA) may qualify for this award.
- Only full-time graduate students ( $\geq 9$  credit hours/semester) are eligible to apply for the Graduate Fellowship Award.
- TOEFL is required for international students. A minimal score of 79 iBT, or equivalent, is required.
- Students must maintain full-time status and the minimum GPA requirement during the semester(s) in which the award is given.
- Failure to fulfill any of the award criteria will result in the Fellowship being withdrawn/reduced and repayment by the student to the University for the amount of the award.
- Span of awards: up to 2 years (or 4 semesters) for Master's degree students; up to 4 years (or 8 semesters) for Doctoral degree students.
- Approval of this award does *not* imply eligibility to financial assistance from the University, the state, or the federal government. Neither does it constitute a permanent designation as a Florida Resident for tuition paying purposes nor qualify the student for such designation in the future.
- Students must reapply every Fall semester to continue or renew one's Fellowship.
- The total number of awards in each category may vary each semester due to budget availability.
- Each College Dean recommends graduate students to ORGS for final review and approval.
- **Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Incomplete applications (e.g. incomplete application form, missing supplemental materials, or missing signatures) will *not* be processed.**
- **RESIDENCY STATUS:** Applicant must be classified as an out-of-state resident for the semester of which the support is sought.
