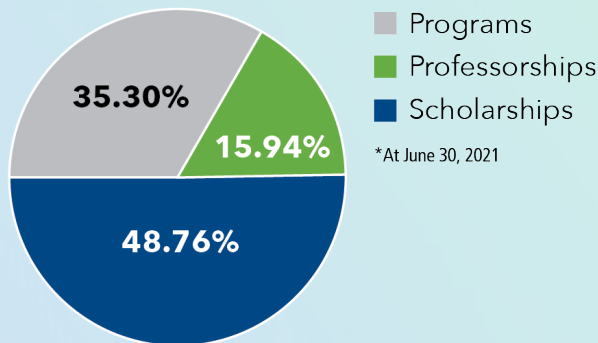


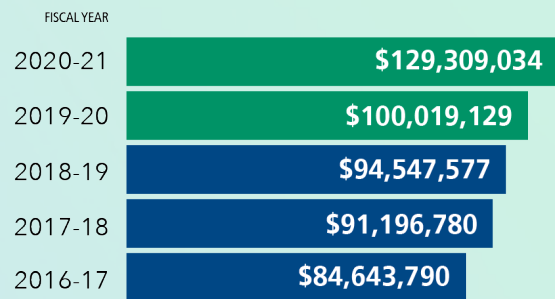

The endowment over the past five years:

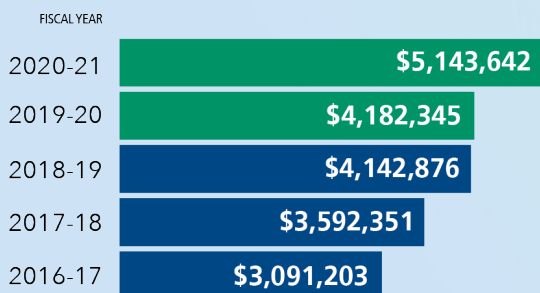
