Investigating the Effect of an Interprofessional Education Experience on Critical Thinking

Upper-level undergraduate courses typically cater to a single major or multiple ones that are similar. These environments do not mimic the real world, where individuals will likely need to interact with people from other disciplines. Three 3000+-level courses in health science, business, and bioengineering were used in this study where all students tackled a real-world problem on their own and then again in randomly-generated, multimajor teams. Critical thinking performance was found to be impacted by the interprofessional education experience; however, effects differed by major.
