Data Science in the Actuary Profession

Speaker: Jerome Tuttle

Data science is a rapidly growing area of study, drawing on both math/statistics and computer science. Actuaries, the mathematicians of the insurance industry, have latched onto data science and are finding interesting uses in their work. The speaker will share some ways actuaries are using data science techniques to find new insights in their data.

Mr. Tuttle is a retired actuary and is currently an online adjunct instructor of math at Rocky Mountain College of Art & Design. Prior to retirement, he was a senior vice president & pricing actuary for Renaissance Reinsurance Company in New York. He is a fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society, a member of the American Academy of Actuaries, and a chartered property and casualty underwriter. He has spoken at Math Teacher Conferences on topics such as copyright and teaching, computer simulation, and the mathematics of love.
