#### Transfer Requirements:

- Completion of an Associate in Arts Degree (AA)
- Cumulative Transfer GPA of 2.0 or higher

#### Important Notes:

- Students must be admitted to FGCU prior to submitting a separate application to the PGM Program. Information about the additional application can be found here: <https://www.fgcu.edu/cob/pga/index.aspx>
- Students will need to provide a handicap verification of 12 or lower as part of the separate application process.
- The PGM program is a limited access program. Qualified students are admitted in the fall semester on a space-available basis.
- Regardless of the amount of transfer credit, this major is a 4-year cohort model. This cohort model is based on the curriculum requirements set forth by the PGA of America.
- Students can double major and/or minor as part of this degree program.
- Internships are a mandatory part of this program. Students will complete 4 separate credit bearing internships totaling at least 16 months of internship.
- The PGM Program has nearly a 100% placement rate due to the internship experiences and first-year mentoring program.

Students are *strongly encouraged* to complete these courses as part of their AA degree to stay on track for a timely graduation. Any remaining prerequisite courses not completed during the AA may delay graduation.
