#### Important Notes:

- All prerequisite courses must be completed with a C or higher (a grade of C– is not acceptable).
- Degree seeking students are classified as pre-majors prior to formal admission into a COE major.
- In order to transition from a COE pre-major to a major, students must complete the following:
  - Submit an application for admission,
  - An overall GPA of 2.0 on all hours attempted,
  - Satisfy General Education requirements,
  - Complete a minimum of sixty (60) credits,
  - Satisfy College-Level Skills requirement,
  - Satisfy common prerequisite requirements, and
  - Successfully complete a background check.
  - Obtain liability insurance for field experiences in the PreK – 12 schools

Students are *strongly encouraged* to complete these courses as part of their AA degree to stay on track for a timely graduation.
