

General Education Revision 2013-2014

- General Education Council (GEC) worked over the summer to develop a draft mission, statement of purpose, and two models for a revised General Education Program using feedback from the previous year's work, and additional research. The models respond to the state mandated changes.
- Details about each of these will be shared during four Town Halls in the early part of the fall semester.
- There will be a Canvas page dedicated to dialoguing and providing feedback about the GEP revisions, and this will be live throughout the fall term.
- At the state level, a preliminary list of “advanced” Mathematics and Natural Science courses has been generated, is in the process of being finalized, will be circulated to the Articulation Coordinating Committee (at the state), and then sent to institutions for final review and approval.
