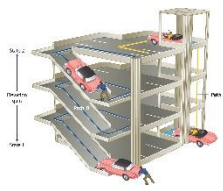


# Parking related issues , solutions

- Not enough parking spaces.
- Students frequently parking on Faculty/Staff spaces including Reserved spaces.
- Students are usually not ticketed due to lack of patrolling several times of the day and/or are forgiven. Understaffed parking office. Student workers for patrolling and ticketing.

## Solutions:

- **Gate system** for Faculty/staff parking spaces.
- Dedicated Parking garage and large lot, dedicated Level 1 in each garage for Faculty/staff parking only, **with Gate**.
- **Parking Management System**, vehicle counting at lots and in garages.
  - **Shared** Reserve space.
- **Frequent** patrolling and ticketing with non-student staff (if no gate).



# Parking related issues , solutions

## Issues with Garages:

- Incoming/Outgoing traffic thru the same entrance/exit
  - Traffic hazard at the peak times
    - Speeding cars
- Not enough lighting, lights out, not fixed for weeks
  - Dirty garages

## Solutions:

- **One way traffic** in the garage. Separate entrance and exit (Garage 4 especially)
  - **Slow down, speed limit signs** at every turn
  - **Officers directing traffic** at the garage exit
    - **Speed bumps**
- **Vehicle count and light system** showing how full the levels are.
  - More lights. Frequent maintenance and cleaning
