# Objective

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To keep computers and personnel working more efficiently by providing easier access to software needed for daily operations, thus reducing vulnerabilities to University workstations from malicious software or applications that could put the University network at risk.



# The Secure PC Model

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- Determines necessary applications
- Provides simplified installation of software
- Software vetted prior to installation

# Benefits

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- Greater System Stability
- Regulatory Compliance
- Software Updates and Patches

# Impact on System

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- Users of a secure PC are not administrators of the system. This means:
  - Users may not be able to install/remove certain software themselves
  - Users may not be able to modify certain configuration settings, such as updating drivers, pre-configured wireless networking settings or other security settings
- Software is usually installed from pre-packed application maintained by BTS

# Secure PC and FGCU Faculty

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- BTS is providing this service to all faculty/staff members
- BTS has taken every precaution to prevent this from impacting your work
- Worked with Faculty Technology Team to address this and other concerns and find solutions to commonly asked questions

# Secure PC Opt Out Process

- Process for full time faculty members
- Request an exemption from Secure PC via opt out form
- Exemption is granted:
  - For the faculty member requesting the exemption
  - On the computer requested for
- Exemption is good until PC is replaced or transferred to a different user



## Secure PC Opt Out Request Form for FGCU Faculty

Secure PC is FGCU's program that enables users to have their computer managed more closely by FGCU. This program ensures that computers stay up to date and secure by centrally managing installed software applications. By removing administrative rights from the day to day users of the computers, the computers are protected against downtime caused by malicious software, or accidental changes.

Faculty may opt out of this processes and be granted administrative rights on their computer, but must exercise due care with the daily use of their computers and follow to the [FGCU's Technology Acceptable Use Policy and Procedure](#), as well as [FGCU's Restricted Data Policy](#).

This form is required to initiate the request to opt out of Secure PC program for faculty members. Submission of this form does not guarantee approval. This request will be processed within 5 business days. FGCU faculty members are the only ones eligible.
