Re: Delegations of Authority

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As you may recall, on May 10, 2016 the Florida Gulf Coast University Board of Trustees (the Board) adopted a Resolution on Presidential Authorizations (Resolution) which addressed the President's authority and responsibility related to the operation and administration of the University. Through the Resolution the Board delegated to the President certain portions of its authority from the Board of Governors, but also/further retained certain of its authority related to the University. This Resolution also addressed and modified authority previously held by the President.

In light of the Resolution and changes made to authority previously delegated, it may be necessary to address authority previously delegated from the President to his Vice Presidents (delegees) and further from the Vice Presidents to their direct reports (sub-delegees).

**Notwithstanding, for all delegees and sub-delegees who are currently operating under authority previously delegated, you may continue to operate under such authority.** If the Resolution has affected the authority you currently hold, you will be notified and will receive a new document that addresses the level of authority you should have, consistent with the Resolution.
