- S/U grades will **NOT** be accepted for milestone, prerequisite, or upper level program courses.
- **Milestone: 3 out of 5 BSW prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of B- or better. Other prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C or better (a grade of C- or less is not acceptable). Earn an overall GPA of 2.5 or greater on coursework from all institutions by the end of Semester 4.**
