- The Plan of Study for Social Work suggests students complete BSC 1005/L though students may also take BSC 1010C, BSC 1085C.
- Milestone: 3 out of 5 BSW prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of B- or better. Other prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C or better (a grade of C- or less is not acceptable). Earn an overall GPA of 2.5 or greater on coursework from all institutions by the end of Semester 4.
