Transfer Requirements:

- Completion of an Associate in Arts Degree (AA)
- Cumulative Transfer GPA of 2.0 or higher

Important Notes:

- All prerequisite courses must be completed with a C or higher (a grade of C– does not meet requirement).
- Students may not pursue this major as a Dual Major or Double Major.
- As part of this major degree requirements, students will complete 9 credits of restricted electives that must be outside of business or entrepreneurship. Consider your options to study coursework in other disciplines!
- The Interdisciplinary Entrepreneurship Studies Major is part of the School of Entrepreneurship. The School of Entrepreneurship has opportunities for all students to live in the Entrepreneurship Living Learning Community and gain access to the Runway Program Incubator.
