DUI: Did You Know?



Everyone knows that driving under the influence of alcohol is something you're not supposed to do, but did you know that driving while intoxicated is one of America's deadliest problems? Over 9,000 people were killed in accidents involving drunk drivers in 2014 alone, and one-third of those deaths happen to innocent people who were either passengers, in another car, or a pedestrian.

Sadly, FGCU has seen its fair share of intoxicated driving. **Between October 2015 and October 2016, there were 20 DUI (driving under the influence) or Zero Tolerance stops just on campus.** DUIs are both time consuming and expensive; check out the "Is the cost of a DUI worth the risk?" section below to see just how much they can cost you. Is the cost of a DUI worth the risk?

Costs of a DUI:

- **Bail:** \$150-\$2,500
- **Car tow:** \$100-\$1,200
- **Attorney fees:** \$2,500-\$5,000
- **Court fines:** \$150-\$1,800
- **Jail fee:** \$10-\$50
- **Probation supervision:** \$600-\$1,200
- **License reinstatement:** \$21-\$100
- **Sentencing fee:** \$250
- **Alternate transportation:** \$100-1,000
- **Increased insurance premiums:** \$4,500-\$10,000
- **Miscellaneous fees:** \$2,000-\$4,600

TOTAL: \$13,000-\$27,000
